



The South African Police Service hereby invites unemployed graduates who conform to the requirements for a twelve (12) months Graduate Recruitment Scheme at **Division: Crime Intelligence**. The Graduate Recruitment Scheme is part of the National Human Resource Development Strategy and the National Skills Development Strategy.

Generic requirements:

- *Be a South African citizen;
- *Must be in possession of National Senior Certificate / Senior Certificate / National Certificate Vocational (level 4);
- *Must have no previous criminal conviction(s) or case(s) pending;
- *Applicants must be unemployed, never employed in the field of the advertised post and never participated in an internship program relevant to the field of the post;
- *Applicants must be residents of the Province where the post is advertised *Applicants are restricted to apply for only three (3) posts and complete separate application forms for each post reference number.

Intern categories with minimum requirements:

Graduate Intern: Tertiary Qualification is required (Statement of Results must be attached).

- * Assist with Collation and consolidation of crime and stability-related information in support of analysts with the Division, Crime Intelligence; generate proactive intelligence reports/products (threat and risk assessments and early warnings) on crime and stability issues with SAPS; generate re-active intelligence reports/products (profiles and intelligence analysis) on crime and stability issues within SAPS.
